Whilst the country itself is about to enter another potentially catastrophic inflationary period with the introduction of the new local 'bond' note (supposedly equivalent to the USD) due any day, those whom we have been assisting have been surging ahead with their education and progress.

I have never felt quite so much that our work, as limited as it is, really is making a permanent difference to those whom we are assisting. In the past there have been moments when I have wondered whether we are being constructive or not, given the fact that so much aid in the third world appears to achieve so little. Yet this time I realised that we have given so many of these young people a chance in life, an opportunity to be someone with a skill, some genuine heartfelt self-belief and a determination to make their lives work.

One young man, Morgan, said it all. *"... until now we have been rejected by society, but now we can walk proudly and make things as good and maybe better than others. God bless you many times for what you have done"*.

I certify that I would like ZAWT to treat my donation as a gift aid donation. Please treat as Gift Aid donations all qualifying gifts of money made today, in the past 4 years and in the future. I confirm I have paid or will pay an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax for each tax year (6 April to 5 April) that is at least equal to the amount of tax that all the charities or Community Amateur Sports Clubs (CASCs) that I donate to will reclaim on my gifts for that tax year. I understand that other taxes such as VAT and Council Tax do not qualify. I understand the charity will reclaim 28p of tax on every £1 that I gave up to 5 April 2008 and will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 that I give on or after 6 April 2008.
