The National elections are due on 30th July, so the nation waits to see whether Mnangagwa can win a truly democratic election.

Even if he does, it will take a number of years to turn around the economy enough to really benefit the average citizen. We feel pleased to have helped so many farmers and farmworkers in difficult times and have been delighted to contribute to the education of so many young people and in particular to have helped eight of them reach University level.

The negotiations for compensation for former farmers continue – nothing is carved in stone, so they wait and hope. Mnangagwa seems willing, but where will the money come from?

There is much still to do. We are currently at a very low financial ebb – a challenging position: We would like to continue to provide support for all the projects described in the accompanying newsletter and to be able to once again assist Borradaile Trust whom we have helped for so many years.

I understand that other taxes such as VAT and Council Tax do not qualify.
