Dear Friends,

Many of you will have recently heard that the Zimbabwe Government have now banned the US dollar and certified that 'Bond' notes are the new official Zimbabwean currency. This came as a dramatic shock to many, whose bank accounts until that moment were classified as USD accounts, now instantly transferred to ZWD accounts, and the exchange rate is now ZW\$9.26 to US\$1. This means that a retired farmers wife we recently heard of, who had sold her house a few months ago for US\$100,000.00 and put the money in the bank, after the government's 'stealing' of the currency, that figure is now worth USD10,750.00.

That is a staggering loss. Sadly, Zimbabwe appears to be spiralling downwards once more and those we help will be in a dreadful situation. Coupled with 17 hour a day power cuts, the country is all but crippled. FEWSNET (Famine Warning Network) has now declared crisis level food shortages in about 80% of Zimbabwe between now and January 2020.

Hardest hit for us will be those who have no other supporting income than those funds coming from ZAWT. In particular, the six farm orphans we are putting through University/college, who were already destitute when we started helping them. They really do need our help.

Any support you feel you could give would be hugely welcome. If you have not already done so, and you are willing to set up a standing order of say £10 or £20 or more per month, that would be even better. Setting up a standing order could not be easier. Please see the back of this page or the last page of the newsletter for full instructions.

I hope you enjoy our newsletter and we look forward to hearing from you and thank you all so much for all the help you have given us over the years.
